

INDUSTRIAL MECHANIC (PRIORITY PRODUCTION TECHNOLOGY OR MAINTENANCE)

An industrial mechanic learns how to install production plants (e. g. a transfer press) and is able to find and remove errors at the plant.

Within this he mounts and dismantles devices and system parts or assembles tools. In case of a defect an industrial mechanic arranges a functional check.

Afterwards he detaches producer goods and is responsible for the quality of the products. By means of working papers industrial mechanics assemble components to devices and these to machines. The working is mechanical or manual. Moreover, he examines the operability of the devices and commissions them.

Further jobs of industrial mechanics are documentations of test results, interception of the manufacturing process and the maintenance of the machines and plants.

The introduction of workmen can also be an occupation of this profession.

In the second year of training you have to specialize on industrial engineering, welding practice or administration and maintenance.
